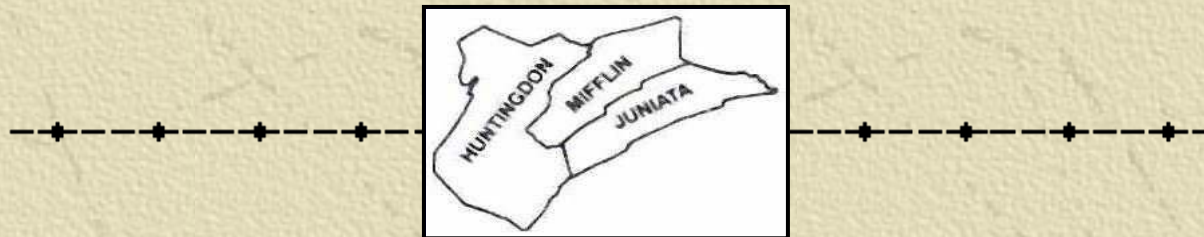
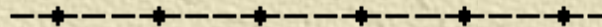


Juniata Valley Tri-County Mental Health Housing Continuum

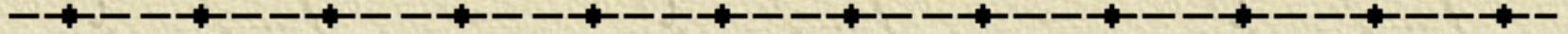

Supported Living Program

- For individuals who need support in addition to case management and traditional outpatient services to maintain their living arrangement in the community.
- This could include but not be limited to the following: administration of medications, food planning/shopping/preparation, socialization, budgeting, room/apartment/house cleaning, hygiene, etc
- Case management extension – providing hands-on assistance, “whatever it takes” approach to maintaining the individual’s living in the community.
- Designed to provide whatever is necessary to promote an individual’s recovery.
